




Kentucky Junior Academy of Science Delegate Selection

- The Kentucky Academy of Science is committed to send at least 6 delegates to the annual American Junior Academy of Science (AJAS) meeting.
- Eligible students must be Kentucky high school students presenting an oral presentation at the KAS/ KJAS Annual Meeting, and receiving a top rating for their research presentation.
- Top scoring students will be chosen as delegates from each of Kentucky's six congressional districts
- If there are no representatives from a district, additional students may be chosen from the district where the Annual Meeting is held.
- In the case of a tied score, we may choose a student from a less represented KAS Division (Physical Sciences, Biological Sciences, Social Sciences)
- KAS will provide chaperones to AJAS. Students do not need to bring a chaperone with them and KAS will not pay or additional chaperones. KAS pays for Delegates' AJAS registration, travel and hotel costs.
